

Instructions

5x7 Inch Envelope


Step 1) Upload the SVG file

Open up Cricut Design Space and upload the file called `svg-envelope-5x7-craftwithsarah.svg`

After uploading, the design will show in your “Recently Uploaded Images”.


Click on it and then press “Add to Canvas” to put it onto your Project.

It should load in at 11.356 inches wide and 14.075 inches tall.



Step 2) Ungroup the layers


Click the design and Ungroup the layers.




Step 3) Format the score line

If you do not have a Cricut scoring wheel or scoring stylus then click the blue rectangle layer and delete it.

If you DO have a scoring wheel/stylus, click on the blue rectangle layer and change it to a Score line under the "Operations" dropdown.



Select the score layer and the larger rectangle layer underneath it and "Attach" them together.



Step 4) Check the envelope size

Double-check that the envelope will fit your card design before you cut it out by adding the card to the Project and make sure it fits inside the dashed score line with a little bit of a gap around all the edges.

If it doesn't resize the envelope to fit.



Step 5) Make the envelope

Cut out the envelope. It works best cut from scrapbook paper or very lightweight cardstock.

Fold upwards along all the score lines.

Use glue or double-sided tape to attach all four envelope flaps.



Stick three of the flaps together. Leave the fourth one unstuck so you can put your card inside!



Once you've put the card inside, glue or tape the final flap down.
